SUBJECT:

Accessibility and Accommodations Training for SPED Educators

The Assessment Section in the Office of Strategy, Innovation and Performance is offering one-day training sessions on Accessibility and Accommodations in instruction and assessment.

The one-day training sessions are intended for:

- 1. Special Education Teachers
- 2. Special Education Department Chairs
- Student Services Coordinators (SSCs)

Participants will learn about the appropriate use of accessibility supports in classroom instruction and assessment. Current accessibility supports available for state testing will also be reviewed along with processes for documenting student designated supports and accommodations in the Individualized Education Program (IEP), 504, and English Language Learner (ELL) records.

Participants will:

- Receive in-depth training on the identification of appropriate accessibility supports for classroom instruction and assessment;
- Review processes for documenting designated support and accommodation needs within IEP, 504, and ELL plans;
- Understand the procedures for setting, requesting, and/or verifying accessibility supports for statewide assessments in TIDE (Test Information Distribution Engine);
- Become familiar with Hawaii's Alternate Assessment Student Identification Process;
- Learn about the 1% federal cap on alternate test participation; and,
- Receive information on current and emerging national trends in accessibility supports.

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Trainings will be held on various dates and at various locations throughout the state from September 7 – 28, 2018.

REGISTRATION

Special education teachers, SPED department chairs, and SSCs should complete the online registration form at https://alohahsap.org > Smarter Balanced > Accessibility and Accommodations Training by Friday, August 17, 2018. Space is limited so please register before the deadline as registration requests will be approved in the order they are received.

School-level staff who wish to attend are to register for the training session for the District in which their school is located. Hana, Lanai and Molokai residents are encouraged to register for the training session on Maui, however, if more convenient, these individuals may register for the Honolulu or Central Oahu session held at McKinley Community School for Adults.

All registrants will receive an automated confirmation email that verifies that the online registration has been successfully completed.
