## **HSA-Alt POLICY PERFORMANCE LEVEL DESCRIPTORS**

Policy Performance Level Descriptors are general statements about the knowledge, skills, and abilities of students at each performance level.

Proficiency Level	Description
Exceeds	Students demonstrate <b>thorough</b> knowledge and skills related to the essence of grade-level content standards and <b>exceed the requirements for proficiency</b> and for postsecondary opportunities, such as continuing education or competitive integrated employment.
Meets	Students demonstrate <b>adequate</b> knowledge and skills related to the essence of grade-level content standards and <b>meet the requirements for proficiency</b> and for postsecondary opportunities, such as continuing education or competitive integrated employment.
Approaches	Students demonstrate <b>partial or inconsistent</b> knowledge and skills related to the essence of grade-level content standards and <b>approach the requirements for proficiency</b> and for postsecondary opportunities, such as continuing education or competitive integrated employment.
Well Below	Students demonstrate <b>minimal</b> knowledge or skills related to the essence of grade-level content standards and <b>do not meet requirements for proficiency</b> and for postsecondary opportunities, such as continuing education or competitive integrated employment.

**NOTE:** All Alternate Performance Level Descriptors assume that student curriculum and assessment is based on content standards that have been reduced in depth, breadth, and complexity. For Parents: Because your child has a significant cognitive disability, he or she was provided a specially designed test called the Hawaii State Assessment- Alternate (HSA-Alt). The HSA-Alt is designed for students with significant cognitive disabilities. HSA-Alt test results for a particular grade cannot be compared to Smarter Balanced or HSA Science Bridge test results at that same grade.
