

HSA-Alternate Summative Test Administrator Requirements, School Year 2021-2022

HSA-Alternate (HSA-Alt) summative Test Administrators (TAs) must be informed about their responsibilities and requirements, including the HSA-Alt summative test administration policies and procedures. Each HSA-Alt Test Administrator must:

- 3. Complete the online HSA-Alt TA Certification course.

The online HSA-Alt Test Administration Certification Course is required for new HSA-Alt Test Administrators (TAs) and recommended for experienced TAs who need a refresher. The course is available on the HSA-Alt portal via the Teachers or the Test Coordinators and Administrators page > Preparing for Testing > Online TA Certification Course.

4. Initiate the "Alternate Assessment" statewide assessment option in the eCSSS.

Select the "Alternate Assessment" option under the "Statewide Assessment" tab in a student's IEP (in eCSSS) upon determination by the school IEP Team, based on the HSA-Alt Participation Guidelines (refer to item 2b above), that the Alternate Assessment is the most appropriate summative assessment option for the student.

5. <u>Document accessibility supports for students who will be taking the HSA-Alternate Assessments in eCSSS</u> (refer to item 2c above).

For assistance with entering data and other applications in the eCSSS, first contact supports within your school. If support is not available at your school, contact your District Special Education Resource Teachers (RTs) and/or the IT Help Desk online or by phone at (808) 564-6000 for assistance.

6. Set accessibility supports (designated supports, accommodations) in the TIDE.

TAs can set the accommodations, except the paper/pencil test form, that their students need directly in the TIDE. Access TIDE via the <u>HSA-Alt portal</u> > <u>Teachers</u> or the <u>Test Coordinators and Administrators</u> page > Preparing for Testing > <u>TIDE</u> (refer to item 2d above).

7. <u>Complete the online (combined) Learning Characteristics Inventory (LCI) and the Hawai'i Observational Rating Assessment (HIORA).</u>

Certified TAs must arrange to have the combined LCI/HIORA form completed (by a school faculty member who is most familiar with the student) before a student can begin HSA-Alt summative testing. Access the LCI/HIORA via the <u>HSA-Alt portal</u> on the <u>Teachers</u> or the <u>Test Coordinators and Administrators</u> page > Administering Tests > <u>TA Live Site</u> (refer to item 2f above).

- 8. Set up summative test sessions and be able to navigate through them (refer to item 2f above).
- 9. <u>Be informed about test security policies and procedures, including the Code of Ethics (refer to item 2g above).</u>
