SUBJECT: Accepting Applications for HSA-Alt Next Generation Science Standards

Performance Level Descriptor (PLD) Review Committees

The Assessment Section is accepting applications from interested teachers, content specialists. and community members for the Hawaii State Alternate Assessment (HSA-Alt) Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) Performance Level Descriptor (PLD) Review Committees. The NGSS will be the basis of all state-wide science assessments beginning in School Year 2019-2020. Selected participants will review and provide feedback on the HSA-Alt Item Specifications for NGSS. HSA-Alt Item Specifications are used for designing assessment tasks for students with significant cognitive disabilities who take the HSA-Alt. Three panels: grade band 3-5, grade band 6-8 and high school, will be formed for to review the newly developed PLDs.

The HSA-Alt Range PLD Review Committee meeting dates are January 2, 3 and 4, 2019. Committee members must be available from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on all three days that the committee meets. The location for all meetings is at the American Institutes for Research (AIR) Honolulu office at 1601 Kapiolani Boulevard, Suite 900.
